CONVENIENCE FEES OF ALAFILE TO BE ASSESSED AS COSTS


Whereas, an order of the Supreme Court Dated July 29, 2005 authorized the filing of court documents electronically and:

Whereas, in many instances parties participating in the electronic filing of court documents are desirous of having the convenience fees, that being four percent, taxed as costs, and:

Whereas, the Judges of the 23rd Judicial Circuit of Madison County, Alabama, seek now to establish an expedient and uniform method of allowing such charges to be assessed as court costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the premises considered, it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that **UPON WRITTEN REQUEST**, the expenses of electronically filing of court documents shall be assessed by the clerk as court costs upon submission of an affidavit in support of such.
