GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING STANDING PENDENTE LITE ORDER AND STANDING PRE-TRIAL ORDER

The Circuit Court Judges of the 23rd Judicial Circuit having determined that it would be beneficial to the administration of justice in the Circuit Court of Madison County for a General Administrative Order to be entered pertaining to the issuance of a **Standing Pendente Lite Order of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit** upon the filing of original contested divorce complaints and a **Standing Pre-Trial Order for all Domestic Relations Cases**. As such the following is hereby **ORDERED**:

- 1. The **Standing** *Pendente Lite* **Order of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit** (attached hereto) shall apply in every original contested divorce action filed in this Judicial Circuit.
- 2. The party filing the initial action shall attach to the complaint the **Standing Pendente Lite**Order of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit (referenced above) which shall be served with the complaint for divorce.
- 3. In the event any party believes that the Standing Pendente Lite Order of the Twenty- Third Judicial Circuit (referenced above) is not appropriate in a given case, a verified motion for relief supported by sufficient allegations of fact to justify the request for relief OR a request for emergency relief shall be filed.
 - (a) If an emergency hearing is requested, and notice of the setting of the requested hearing has not been received within seven (7) days from the date of filing of the case, it shall be the responsibility of counsel, or *pro se* party, who files said request to contact the office of the judge assigned to the case to obtain a hearing date.
- 4. The Standing Pre-Trial Order For Domestic Relations (attached hereto) is to be considered entered in every domestic relations case filed in this Judicial Circuit without further order.

5. Motions for Contempt/Sanctions of a *Pendente Lite* Order of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit will not be heard until the alleged violating party has been served with a *Pendente Lite* Order.
