STANDING ORDER FOR YOUTHFUL OFFENDER APPLICATIONS

The Circuit Judges of the 23rd Judicial Circuit having determined that it would be beneficial to the administration of justice, allow the defendant adequate time to prepare for the interview, and afford the Probation Officer adequate time to prepare for the investigation, hereby enters the following Order pertaining to Youthful Offender Applications:

Within 48 business hours after a motion for Youthful Offender Application has been granted, the defendant must report to the State Probation Office to schedule a Youthful Offender Investigation Interview. If the defendant is incarcerated, the defense attorney shall notify the Probation Office of the defendant's incarceration within 48 business hours after said motion has been granted. Further, the interview must be scheduled no later than 15 calendar days prior to the Youthful Offender Application Hearing, and the interview must take place no later than 10 calendar days prior to the Youthful Offender Application Hearing. This policy will ensure that the Youthful Offender Investigation Report is submitted to the Court, District Attorney's office, and defense attorney at least 7 calendar days prior to said hearing. In the event extenuating circumstances arise, the Probation Officer shall communicate with the Court.
