## FEES OF PROCESS SERVER TO BE TAXED AS COSTS

WHEREAS, court approval for appointment of a special process server is no longer required under Rule 4, Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure, and;

WHEREAS, in many instances, the party seeking such service is desirous of having the expense of such service taxed as costs, and:

WHEREAS, THE Circuit and District Judges of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Judicial Circuit in Madison County, Alabama, seek now to establish an expedient and uniform method of assessing such charges. NOW, THEREFORE, THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that UPON WRITTEN REQUEST, the expenses of service of process paid to special process servers shall be assessed by the clerks of this judicial circuit as court costs upon submission of a paid statement, but however, only to the extent the expenses do not exceed those which would be charged by and paid to the Madison County Sheriff pursuant to applicable law. Notice of a party's desire to seek service by special process server must be filed in writing with the original pleadings, in each civil action to which this order shall apply. All requirements of said Rule 4 regarding such service shall remain applicable.
