GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING DEFAULT JUDGMENTS IN CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

- 3. A copy of this Order shall be distributed to all members of the Huntsville-Madison County Bar Association, shall be posted on the website for the 23rd Judicial Circuit, and shall be maintained in the Circuit Court Clerk's Office and the Court Administrator's Office.
