## STANDING ORDER APPOINTING QUALIFIED INTERPRETERES FOR JUVENILE COURT INTAKE PROCESS

Pursuant to §§ 12-21-131(c) and 15-1-3 (a), Ala Code 1975, authorizing this court to appoint a qualified sign language or foreign language interpreter, respectively, during the juvenile court intake process, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. Effective immediately, and without the need for filing individual motions with this court, when a foreign language or sign language interpreter is requested or otherwise required, it is hereby Ordered that a qualified deaf or foreign language interpreter shall be provided during the juvenile court intake process conducted pursuant to §§ 12-15-118 and 12-15-120, Ala. Code 1975, and Rule 12 of the Alabama Rules of Juvenile Procedure.
- 2. The qualified deal or foreign language interpreter shall provide interpreter services and shall be compensated pursuant to §§ 12-21-131(j) and 15-1-3(d), Ala. Code 1975, and Alabama's Foreign Language Court Interpreter Policies and Procedures.
- 3. This Order shall remain in force and effect until further order of this Court.
