


IN THE JUVENILE COURT OF MADISON COUNTY, ALABAMA

STANDING ORDER
APPOINTING QUALIFIED INTERPRETERS
FOR JUVENILE COURT INTAKE PROCESS

Pursuant to §§ 12-21-131(c) and 15-1-3 (a), Ala Code 1975, authorizing this court to appoint a qualified sign language or foreign language interpreter, respectively, during the juvenile court intake process, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

1. Effective immediately, and without the need for filing individual motions with this court, when a foreign language or sign language interpreter is requested or otherwise required, it is hereby Ordered that a qualified deaf or foreign language interpreter shall be provided during the juvenile court intake process conducted pursuant to §§ 12-15-118 and 12-15-120, Ala. Code 1975, and Rule 12 of the Alabama Rules of Juvenile Procedure.
2. The qualified deaf or foreign language interpreter shall provide interpreter services and shall be compensated pursuant to §§ 12-21-131(j) and 15-1-3(d), Ala. Code 1975, and Alabama's Foreign Language Court Interpreter Policies and Procedures.
3. This Order shall remain in force and effect until further order of this Court.
