
STANDING ORDER REGARDING DISCOVERY IN CRIMINAL CASES


The Judges of the 23rd Judicial Circuit having determined that a Standing Order Regarding Discovery in criminal cases would benefit the administration of justice, it is hereby **ORDERED**:


Effective immediately, use of audio/video recordings produced by the State of Alabama is limited to the criminal case in which it is produced, and may be viewed only by the defendant, counsel of record, expert witnesses or consultants, and officers of the Court. Without leave of Court, copies made by defense counsel may not be provided to defendant or a third party, other than expert witnesses or consultants.


